- 1) **Calls:**

- 2) **Reports (for 842)**
  - Reports are very important
  - Be sure they are accurate and thorough for every call – do not speculate
  - Do not include BP, temperature, pulse, etc. on the report unless a HLR firefighter took the information
  - Reports are legal documents and must be factual
  
- 3) **Check Trucks**
  - Be sure to check your trucks and the equipment carefully
  
- 4) **Fill Point**
  - Fill point (water tower) at 312 is unavailable
  
- 5) **Wood County School**
  - Schedule for Saturday, September 13 at Quitman Fire Department
  - **Need applications by August 19**
  - All HLVFD firefighters must attend morning class (9:00 to noon)
  - Limited to two firefighters per fire department to attend SCBA session (beginner → advanced) – see Joe if interested in attending
  - Try to attend
  - Some will need to stay back to cover station
  
- 6) **Charley**
  - All rescue firefighters need to complete TEKS classes this year when offered – see Charley if any questions
  
- 7) **New medical truck (Bill)**
  - Found a 2009 Ford Explorer in Tyler with 79,000 miles; 4-door; white for \$18,000 (includes license and title)
  - Requesting \$25,000 to purchase the truck and equipment (siren, lights, radio, decals, etc.)
