- 3) **Foam:** Corey Clanton (Chief of Hainesville) said the reason we get air in the hose is because we do short bursts. We have to have the nozzle on full or not at all. No short bursts...
- 4) **Brush 847:** The pump is fried. It will cost \$2098 to replace it. It is being repaired now.
