- 4) **Chief:** Talked to guys at XTO Energy w/Stephen Holmes from Hawkins FD. They have a new facility on 1795 with an elevator; offices on second floor. They have two stairwells AND two stair chairs (woohoo). SO if we have to bring someone down from the second floor and the elevator is not working, we have a way to get them down easier than a gurney. They have a fire hydrant that pumps 1500 gal/min. next to the building by the electrical box and a sprinkler system that does 60 lb. per sq. in. They have a Lab in a separate single story building that has no sprinkler system or anything. No tornado siren. They do have an Alert system that uses the same tone for everything.
