## Regular Training Meeting Minutes October 17, 2017

Meeting brought to order by Chief Joe Cirasola.

- 1) **Speeding**: *Keep it down*. Security talked to Chief (again). Please be aware of your speed. If the call is a cardiac arrest, then get there; but, if the call is anything else, then **be aware of your speed**.
- **Fall Festival**: October 29 at Summit Heights at 5:00pm to 7:00pm. Be at the station at 4:30pm; dress is Class A. We will take an Engine, a Tanker, and Rescue 842.
- 3) Trunk or Treat: October 31 at Holly Hall. Chief will let us know about time and dress code.
- **Hot Dog Sale**: Had a request from Car Club Shine for hot dog sales. They said if we supply the hot dogs and the fixin's, they would sell them; HLVFD would get the proceeds. We respectfully declined.
- 5) Veterans Day Dinner: November 6 at Alert Academy at 6:30pm. Dress is Class A. Let Chief know if you want to attend. **NOTE**: If you say you are going, then be there.

## **6) Bill**:

- New forms for Omni get them done tonight.
- Structure Boots: The Board of Directors talked about and decided that we need new structure boots. We are getting Globe boots (a better boot) at a cost of \$345 per pair for a total cost of \$2800. Corey Ervin made a motion to buy the boots; Doug Attaway seconded. Approved. Boots will be ordered.
- New Can Hauler Trailer: There is a problem getting Merton to pick up cans; they charge 20% to take them away. Therefore, we are buying a trailer to do it ourselves. The cost is \$3500 from Texas Brag. Don Wolford made a motion to purchase a can hauler trailer; Jim DuBois seconded. Approved. Trailer will be purchased.
- John from EMS: We appreciate you all very much. (1) If you have a problem with a medic, let him know. (2) There is a red box in the bay for bio-hazard stuff; we can dispose of our gloves there. (3) If you want to be in the box, you can get there, per John. But, per chief, ask BEFORE you get in. Some medics prefer for us not to be in the box.

  Also, per Chief, DO NOT pick up anyone without EMS on scene.
- 8) **Don W**.: Do not put patient information (i.e., blood pressure, pulse, etc.) on the Radio Log; Per Chief (this is a change). DO NOT put the vitals on the Run Report. Only put the chief complain and mode of transport on the Run Report.
- 9) **Bill**: Run reports need to be put in ALL trucks.

10) **Don L**. It is that time of year – need to start thinking about nominees for: Firefighter of the Year, Officer of the Year, and Distinguished Service. Send nominations to Chief ONLY by email, handwritten or typed note. Be sure to sign it.

Also, there are three Board positions coming available: Bill, Vern, and Travis. Are all up for reelection. The Chief's position is also up for re-election. Start thinking about nominees and get them in to the Chief soon. Elections are in December.
